# BERNIE'S WORDS

Our thanks go to Charlie Woodruff of FLEET FEET SPORTS, who was the guest speaker at our last meeting. Charlie spoke to us about stretching the muscles of our body to relax and prepare for a 10K walk. As we get older, it becomes more important to stretch, not only when you are exercising but as a daily routine. I'm not the one to preach, because I'm not very good at practicing what I know to be best for me; the only time I work at stretching is to relieve the soreness and pain of injuries due to omitting a stretching routine for the correct muscles before golf or walking.

The best time to stretch is when the muscles are warmed up...this usually occurs at about 10 to 15 minutes into the walk. It becomes impractical on our group walks (Wednesday), but stretching could work and be part of your routine when doing a Traditional event, Year-Round or Seasonal walks.

Our Wednesday walks are in full swing, and with our kick off walks we are overwhelmed with opportunities for walking. Don't feel pressured with all the walking opportunities; get the walk in when you and your friends can get together. Wednesday walks must be done on that day, but our seasonal and year-rounds can be done at your leisure.
